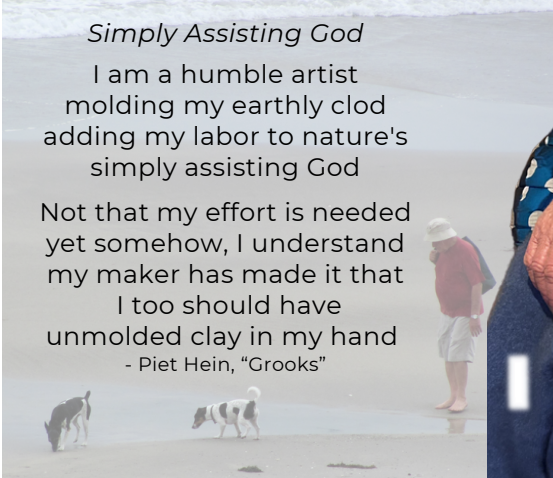




*Simply Assisting God*
